Be sure to emphasize the Topic or Questions you are addressing, why you've chosen the project and explain its importance and potential contribution in your field. In addition, be sure to include a description of your research strategy, explaining what steps will lead you to answer of the questions you hope to address.
 - A current resume.
 - Unofficial graduate and undergraduate transcripts.
- 4. Your application must be emailed to the above address no later than May 20, 2018 at midnight. All applicants will be notified by the Society of their status by June 8, 2018. - The Society requires one bound copy of the completed thesis. Additionally, regular written updates to the Society maybe required.
- The Society reserves the right to publish all or part of the Grantee's thesis as part of any Four Corners Geological Society publication.
